- In June, REACH launched BCF's first domestic missions trip: Commissioned: Virginia 2026!
- The team stayed at the BCF Retreat Center, rooted in worship, Bible study, prayer, and fellowship.
- By God's grace, students were connected to BCF, missionaries were equipped, and several gave their lives to Christ.

BELIEVING GOD FOR — WHAT'S NEXT

- Expand Commissioned to additional states in 2027, maximizing school breaks to reach more campuses.
- Future trips will require support for transportation, housing, and ministry expenses.
- Long-term vision: raise and commission full-time missionaries to serve campuses nationwide.

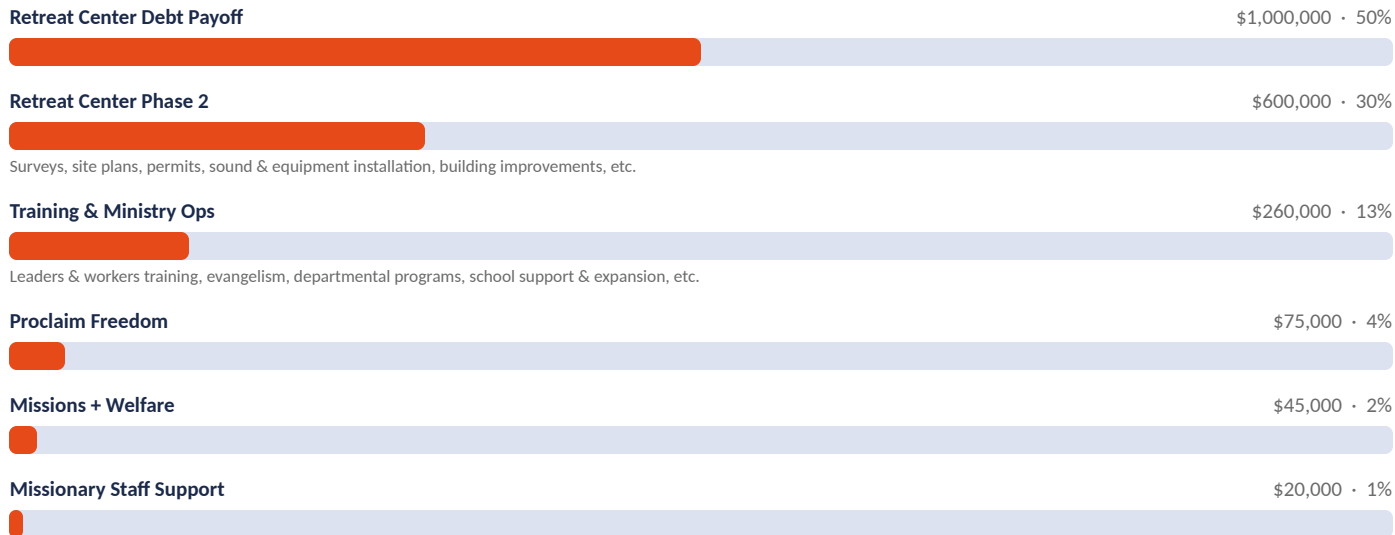

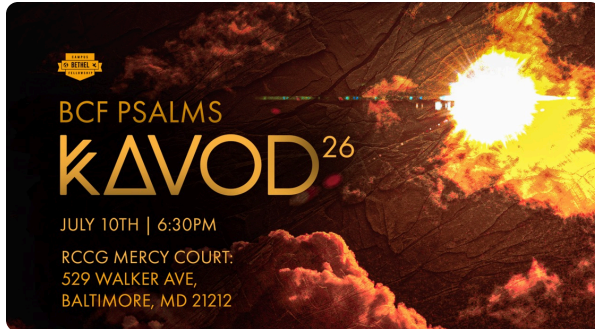
